Decision

The Department of Environment has searched Fish and Wildlife Branch and has identified records responsive to Access Request #22-344. The final response on the information is as follows:

Access Granted in Part

The Department of Environment is granting access in part to information relating to the request noted below:

All information related to all thinhorn sheep harvested by licensed resident and non-resident hunters within the date period listed. Data for each sheep harvest to include the following details: - Date of harvest - Game management zone and subzone of harvest - Harvested by resident or non-resident - Nearest landmark description - Horn length No names of harvesters are requested.

Some of the records you requested contain information that has been withheld from disclosure under the ATIPP Act. We have severed the excepted information so that we could disclose to you the remaining information in the records. The records have been withheld pursuant the following sections under the Access to Information and Protection Privacy Act (ATIPP Act):

- Section 77(1)(b) disclosure of the information may result in similar information no longer being supplied to the responsive public body and the head is satisfied that it is in the public interest that similar information continue to be supplied.
- Section 78(b) disclosure may result in damage to, or interference with, the conservation or preservation of a species of plant or animal that is endangered, threatened or vulnerable.

Please note that the accuracy and completeness of the 1990-1994 data is uncertain and should therefore be used with caution. Also it is not mandatory for hunters to provide landmark details. Where provided landmark information has been withheld as per sections 77(1)(b) and 78(b) of the Act.
