Decision

The Public Service Commission has searched the Staffing Management and Solutions branch, Labour Relations, and Human Resources Shared Services branch and has identified information responsive to Access Request #22-350. Our final response on the information is as follows:

Access Granted in Full

The Public Service Commission has provided information in full relating to the request noted below:

All Yukon government employees were required to have a first-dose of COVID 19 vaccination by Nov. 30 and a second dose by Jan 30, 2021. As of July 14 2022, vaccination against COVID-19 is no longer be a requirement for employees, volunteers and contractors in any Yukon government workplace. How many people were put on leave without pay due to the vaccination requirements (from Nov 2011 to July 2022)? Of those, what percentage were Indigenous identifying employees? How many people resigned from the Government of Yukon due to the vaccine requirements? Of those, what percentage were Indigenous identifying employees? Timeframe: November 30, 2021 - July 14, 2022.
