## **Decision**

The Public Service Commission has searched the Commissioner's Office, Human Resources Service Centre, Policy and Planning and Labour Relations branch and has identified information responsive to Access Request #22-430. Our final response on the information is as follows:

## **Access Granted in Part**

The Public Service Commission has provided information in part relating to the request noted below:

Records related to discussions about whether the Yukon would declare Sept. 19 a holiday. September 8, 2022 - September 19, 2022.

NARROWED #1: I would like to narrow my request to only include the records listed under "HR Service Centre ADM" on the AIS

NARROWED #2: I'd like to further narrow my request to only include the maximum number of pages that can be processed within the free five hours, beginning with the records at the start of the date range and cutting off whenever five processing hours have been reached.

Cabinet information consisting of advice, recommendations and briefing material prepared for a Minister or Cabinet was redacted using section 67(3)(a) of the ATIPP Act.

Section 72(1)(b)(vi) of the ATIPP Act was used to withhold conference log in information and codes as the disclosure of which could adversely affect the security of a building or communications system.

Solicitor client privilege information has been redacted under section 73(a) of the ATIPP Act.

Advice or recommendations prepared by or for a public body or a Minster have been redacted under section 74(1)(a) of the ATIPP Act.

Out of scope information and duplicate records have been removed. Email attachments with extension.png are a result of file conversion within email signatures and have also been removed as they are not attachments to the emails.
