**RE: Final Response Access Request #22-614**

### **Decision**

The Department of Environment has searched Environment Protection and Assessment and Fish and Wildlife branches and has identified records responsive to Access Request #22-614. The final response on the information is as follows:

### **Access Granted in Part**

The Department of Environment is granting access in part to information relating to the request noted below:

1. Any and all correspondence between the Yukon Department of Environment and Yukon Department of Energy, Mines and Resources, regarding a Reservation by Letter with the Disposition Number 2022-1270. 2. Any application by the Yukon Department of Environment, or correspondence, documents and records, including meeting notes, from the Yukon Department of Environment, related to the creation of an administrative hold on land dispositions for the benefit of the Southern Lakes Caribou Herd. 3. Any documents, correspondence and records internal to the Yukon Department of Environment for rationale or need to limit development and land dispositions in order to protect the Southern Lakes Caribou Herd. 4. The record of consultation with any First Nation affected or potentially affected by Disposition Number 2022-1270.

Timeframe: Aug 05, 2020 - Dec 21, 2022

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

*Clarification from PB: We have received your Access to Information request 22-614 and we require some clarification on your request to assist us with processing it. It will be helpful to know the following about Disposition 2022-1270, such as: The name associated to Disposition 2022-1270, Disposition type, and/or Location associated to Disposition 2022-1270.*

*Response from App: Unfortunately, I do not have the clarifying information as this is what I am trying to better understand with the ATIPP request. All I can do to assist is point you to the results for "2022-1270" using the search function in GeoYukon. It is the information from that search which is prompting this request."*

Some of the records you requested contain information that has been withheld from disclosure under the ATIPP Act. We have severed the excepted information so that we could disclose to you the remaining information in the records. The information has been withheld pursuant the following sections under the Access to Information and Protection Privacy Act (ATIPP Act):

| S78 Disclosure harmful to conservation or heritage site    | Detailed animal location data has been withheld since its release would harm conservation efforts.  |


