## **Decision**

The Department of Environment has searched Animal Health Unit and Policy, Planning and Implementation Branch and has identified records responsive to Access Request #22-649. The final response on the information is as follows:

## **Access Granted in Part**

The Department of Environment is granting access in part to information relating to the request noted below:

On the open Yukon site, where the 2016 Wildlife Risk Assessment from the Canadian Wildlife Health Cooperative is located, there is a statement preluding the report that reads: "This report was produced by the Canadian Wildlife Health Cooperative for the Department of Environment and explores the disease risks related to interaction between wild sheep and domestic sheep and goats. This report does not represent the current policy direction of the Government of Yukon. Staff of the departments of environment and energy, mines and resources are currently evaluating this report and will develop specific plans and recommendations based on the information presented here..." I would like to see the communication between environment and EMR regarding the issuance of this statement, including emails, interdepartmental memos, briefing notes, etc. What is the rationale behind this statement? Why does the policy not follow the recommendations that were made in the report? Thank you.

### **ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:**

ENV: Please confirm that you want your request limited to responsive records between Environment and EMR specific to the quoted statement from the 2016 Wildlife Risk Assessment.

APP: I don't want to limit the response at all, and I just don't know how to communicate very well I'm sure. How do I say that I want anything related to where that statement was derived....?

ENV: If you want to capture anything related to the statement of interest, you could request all records that reference this particular report. This would then include any internal communications and documents within Environment, not just interactions with EMR. For example, it might include the original contract with the consultant which could possibly contain information.

APP: Yes please to what you have suggested to capture the discussions... so including November 1,2015 to October 31, 2016.

#### NARROWED SCOPE:

Response from App: Regarding the note about the Risk Assessment report copies being excluded to reduce the number of pages, yes, please do that. I am very familiar with that document.

Some of the records you requested contain information that has been withheld from disclosure under the ATIPP Act. We have severed the excepted information so that we could disclose to you the remaining information in the records. The records have been withheld pursuant the following sections under the Access to Information and Protection Privacy Act (ATIPP Act):
