# Final Response ATIPP Access Request 22-713

## **Decision**

The Department of Environment has searched the Finance, Client, Business and Technology Solutions, Finance, Environmental Protection and Assessment and Conservation Officer Services branches and has identified no responsive records to Access Request 22-713.

### No Record Found

The Department of Environment has no responsive information relating to the request noted below:

Financial contracts awarded through RFP process or by DM signature related to the services of cleanup land; specifically metals and vehicles (cars, trucks, passenger vehicles, etc). What was the \$ amount awarded? How contracts were awarded to Urban Auto Recycling, specifically for the Industrial McRae lot located at 99 Boulder Road that was leased by [NAME] and the Dawson Group of Companies (property where bears were destroyed) and the Deep Creek Solid Waste Facility (60 Deep Creek Road). I would like to to know the process and how one company was selected and compensated for the work.
