Final Response ATIPP Access Request 23-096

Decision

The Department of Environment has searched Parks Branch and has identified records responsive to Access Request 23-096. The final response on the information is as follows:

Access Granted in Part

The Department of Environment has granted access in part to information relating to the request noted below:

Requesting Yukon parks department park ranger's policies and procedures. Additional Information: I am looking for the one to do with enforcement and more specifically what policies and procedures are in place when issuing tickets to campers.

Certain types of information have been withheld pursuant to the Access to Information and Protection of Privacy Act. A summary of records reviewed and withheld redactions are enclosed.

While not part of the responsive records package, a copy of the new Parks and Land Certainty Act Regulation has also been included. This updated Regulation has not yet been published online but is in force.
