The Department of Energy, Mines and Resources has completed its review of the records responsive to Access Request #23-115 and we are pleased to inform you that access is being granted to the 162 pages of records responsive to this request.

Some of the information has been redacted and withheld from disclosure under:

- subsection 73(a) of the Act because it is subject to legal privilege;
- paragraph 74(1)(a) of the Act, which allows for the discussion of policy issues that may not otherwise occur if the deliberative process were subject to excessive scrutiny; and
- subsection 76(1) of the Act because disclosure of the information could harm relations between the Government of Yukon and another government or organization.
