Miguel,

We are writing to submit budget pricing for the additional playground scope at the Whistlebend Elementary School project. This pricing includes several options that vary based on equipment and surfacing chosen.

This pricing assumes all materials are ordered in 2023. The work will be done during late spring/early summer of 2024. There will be an equipment price increase of 3-5% if equipment is not ordered before 2024.

The breakdown of Ketza pricing for the supply and install is also attached. There will be additional costs for civil works as the requirement for clearances for the equipment increased the areas of each playground, from what was originally designed. Ketza's pricing is based on the assumption that sand surfacing is installed. If a different surface option is chosen, there will need to be a geotechnical review and the pricing may change based on differing reviews for fill.

Final pricing is subject to standard additional fees (overhead/profit/bonding, etc.) This proposed change to the scope is being priced with the assumption that our overall substantial completion date and release of holdback will be unaffected.



Hello Chris;

Attached is a marked up screenshot to show my understanding of what we are asking Ketza to provide final pricing on under CCN-032 for playground equipment.

For Equipment set #2.c (PIP):

Option -2.1 is located where there is a drop in grade of about 1.5 to 2 metres, that would probably require retaining walls plus cut and fill to provide a level area. That would include design to meet the existing slope along the adjacent property line.

Option – 2.2 is located on level ground currently to be turf and reclamation seed finish landscaping.

Concrete walkways (dashed lines) would need to be run to either area. There are a couple of ways that could be done to connect to the current walkways.

Option – 2.1 would be significantly more costly. Grading between the two play areas and the Amphitheatre will be a bit tricky... Ketza's budget pricing dated August 9 doesn't appear to include civil and landscape redesign.

Configuration of Equipment #3.a – Quito on sand would need to be determined for best fit and probably require some area added to the current design.

Please review, let me know if something is incorrect or there are any other questions, and confirm understanding and how we are to proceed with the CCN.

Just spoke with Trevor again and have a good idea of what is intended:

- Locate option #2.c Slide/Net Equipment (on PIP) to the primary area near Option #1.a Swing Set (on sand)
- Revise the original lower space to accommodate Option #3.a Quito Equipment (on sand)

I will discuss with Colliers this afternoon and forward a summary description with the least change as possible – e.g., grading the upper, primary area as needed and fitting the Quito Equipment in the original lower area. That will be forwarded as an update to CCN-032 for Ketza to develop a final layout and confirm pricing.

I believe the discussion with Ketza on site last Thursday noted a potential increase of about 30% in area of the current play space; not sure what they were considering though.

Some questions came up at the meeting after the site visit yesterday.

There seems to be some confusion around the playground and the desired equipment. There are a couple items that need to be confirmed:

- How many playgrounds are there supposed to be? The design shows two, but there seems to an impression that a third playground is to be added. I'm not sure where this is coming from, but I think it is because the school council has requested three playground pieces. Just need to confirm that there is only two.
- What is the equipment that is going to be chosen for the site? From the options that Ketza sent us, what would we like to proceed with? I have attached the options information that they sent us in August for easy reference. This is important to sort out so that the final dimensions for the playground surfacing can be determined. If we decide that we want all the pieces of equipment, then there may need to be some reworking of the pathways and sidewalks around the intermediate playground. With all the playground equipment listed we are looking at a 30% increase in space required for the surfacing area; this will require a redesign for the adjacent spaces.

The question on the Learning Commons and the Security Gate and egress from this space.

When this question first came up, it was about the possibility of a maintenance person being inadvertently locked in this space if they were servicing equipment on the roof. But it seems that the concern is more of a building code issue with emergency egress from the space behind the security gate. What Ketza needs form us is to understand the intended usage of the learning commons and if it will be used afterhours. The intent is to bring this up with the code consultant for building code compliance.

Ketza has submitted a submittal for the paving stones for the outdoor learning area. The SOR specified a size of paving stone that was not a standard size.
