Please inform me of the cost of providing the records electronically in a structured format (e.g. XLS, CSV) via email or CD_ROM via mail. If my request is too broad or does not reasonably describe the records, please contact me via email or telephone so that I may clarify my request. Thank you for considering my request. Timeframe: October 12, 2022 - March 8, 2023
