Decision

The Department of Health and Social Services has searched Community and Primary Care and has identified records responsive to Access Request 21-414. The final response on the information is as follows:

Access Granted in Part

The Department of Health and Social Services has granted access in part to the information relating to the request noted below:

I want access to all correspondence from the Department of Health and Social Services describing instances of patients insulting, verbally and/or physically abusing nurses, physicians and other frontline healthcare staff due to COVID-19 regulations, including those connected to the state of emergency such as the proof-of-vaccination requirement.

Timeframe: November 1, 2021 - November 17, 2021

Certain types of information have been redacted pursuant to the following sections of the Access to Information and Protection of Privacy Act:

- 70(1) – disclosure would be an unreasonable invasion of the third party's privacy
