

**STATEMENT OF POLICY**

This policy describes the procedure to be followed if a perimeter of the correctional centre is breached.

**AUTHORITIES**

*Corrections Act, 2009: ss. 2, 14, 15*












**DEFINITIONS**

Perimeter breach: a planned or unplanned breach in the security of either the correctional centre's secure perimeter or threat perimeter.


Secure perimeter: the physical outer wall of the correctional centre, within which inmates may move without escort.

Threat perimeter: the outer level of security, typically a secure fence, that inmates or persons from outside the correctional centre may reach without challenge.

**PROVISIONS**

1. An officer or WCC employee who observes or detects a breach or possible breach in the perimeter of the correctional centre will immediately
